Current legislation that has been introduced by Representative Bill Taylor H3360 and Senator Young S 248

- South Carolina has had an anti texting law but that does not prevent someone from driving with a cell phone in their hands.
 These bills would amend that section to include hand held devices.
- Both bills are awaiting subcommittee hearings since being introduced on December 9, 2020.
- Both bills will have a warning period (6 months for H3360 and 60 days for S248) and after that there will be fine of not more than (\$100 first offense \$300 second offense for H3360) and (\$500 for S248) and 2 points assessed on their motor vehicle record.
- Both bills have \$25 of the fine going to public awareness campaigns to educate the public on the danger of distracted driving.
- Both bills exclude first responders and tow truck operators if they are using these devices while in the duty of their job.
- Sponsors of H3360 are Representatives Taylor, Haddon, Pope, Forrest and McGinnis.
- Sponsors of S248 Senators Young, Hembree and Turner.
