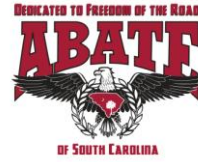


Legislative Meeting Notice

Immediate Release: Legislative Meeting to be held after the 1:00 p.m. ABATE of Greenville meeting. Located at the Greenville Shrine Club located 119 Beverly Road Greenville, SC 29609.

- We will provide an in-depth discussion of current legislation. Hands Free, Carolina Squat Reckless Driving and other legislation.

S 248 and H3360 “SC Hands Free Act” Would make driving with a cell phone in your hand illegal. **S 248 has made it out of subcommittee and full committee.**

S 28 Drivers license suspended due to a DUI interlock requirement exclusion for motorcycles.

H 4506 Would make the property tax 1/3 of the actual value of the motorcycle.

S 908 and H 4574 Would require that trucks could not be modified over five inches from the front to the back axle. **S 908 has made it out of subcommittee and full committee..**

H 3507 Would require a person driving the vehicle to submit to a drug / alcohol test if the collision creates great bodily injury or death.

S 135 Would increase the penalties for Reckless Vehicular Homicide.

Legislation to amend the current motorcycle helmet law, None Introduced.
